The Pastors' Page

***Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?"
And I said, "Here am I; send me!" (Isaiah 6:8)***

Eastern Kentucky is just on the horizon! Early Sunday morning, June 16, your Red Bird Team will depart for Saint Luke's seventh adventure with Red Bird Mission. When we leave that day, we will go with the knowledge of how well you have supported our efforts through the years—and with the confidence that you will hold us in prayer as we travel and undertake our 2024 project. We give thanks for you and for the great heart that Saint Luke members have for mission and ministry...in the community and beyond.

We are Methodists, and we remember how John Wesley understood his own call to ministry, saying "the world is my parish." That phrase still resonates with us—challenging, directing, and affirming the work that we do today. Not only do our neighbors encompass those who live around us, but they also include those in need beyond our borders. There is no shortage of work to be done. The recent storms and tornado outbreaks in the US remind us of that truth. God does not limit us. Rather, we limit ourselves by where we are willing to go and what we are willing to do.

Our Red Bird project next month will be similar to the one we undertook last year—a floor replacement with other issues to be addressed as the existing floor is taken up. (There are always additional issues! We have stories!) We have worked on homes that were built by the families themselves—*many* years ago. In preparation for summer work teams, Work Camp staff review homeowner requests and determine the feasibility of needed repairs. They also provide tools and order the materials needed for the project. The fees we pay include those materials as well as room and board for team members. The efforts made beforehand and staff oversight during the week enable teams like ours to focus on the work and on building relationships with homeowners. Given the variables and the circumstances, we are committed to doing our best to ensure a safer, more livable home when we leave. If we are unable to finish the task in the allotted time, we are thankful that another team will follow up the next week.

We are blessed with an experienced and capable crew! In addition to folks who have made numerous trips to Red Bird Mission, three newbies are joining us who have much to offer our team. We are grateful for new folks who are willing to donate six days of their time and energy. They give us hope that this effort will continue into the future when some of us will need to bow out. If not Red Bird, we can be sure that there will be other opportunities. After all, we are Methodists! The world is *our* parish!

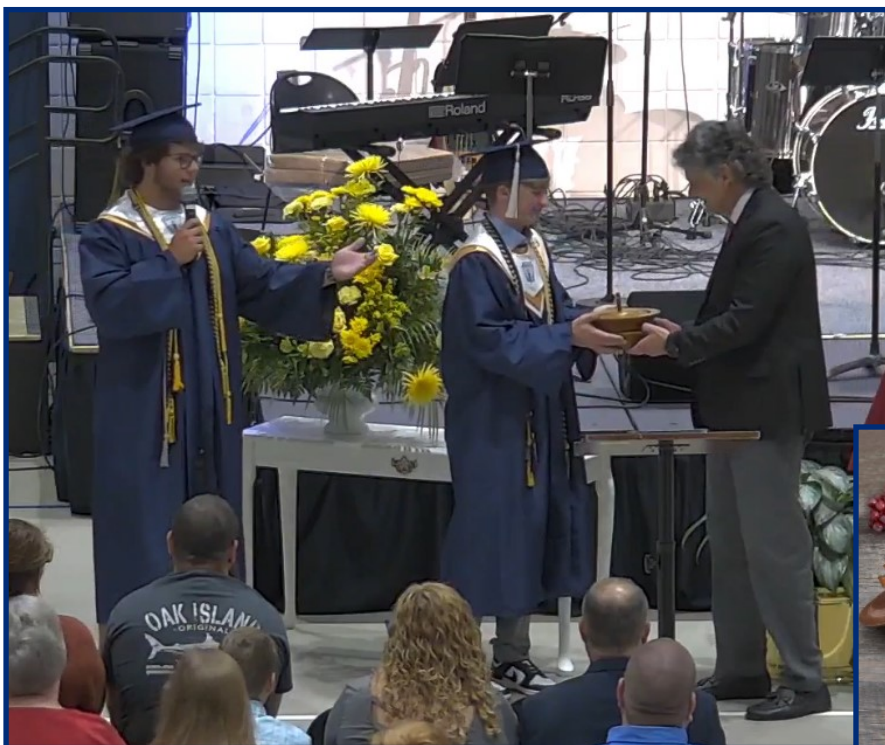

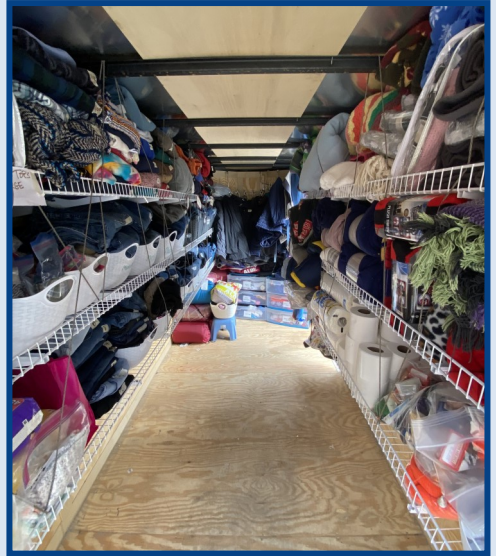
