

"Memories - Timeless Treasures of the Heart"

On Sunday, May 12, Saint Luke UMC will celebrate its 50th anniversary! We will celebrate the vision given to our parents and grandparents, clergy and laity, and other influential leaders at Steele Street UMC when they began conversation about relocating the congregation to a place where they could expand their witness in the Sanford community. The downtown location was landlocked. There was no space to grow.

It was not an easy decision. Honestly, most important decisions are difficult. We know this by those who lived during those days, back in the 1970s. We've heard stories from members who remember what it was like when folks began talking about relocating. Some were interested, some were opposed, some waited to make a decision. Families were not always in agreement about what to do. I can only imagine how tough that time must have been for the church.

But... God has been faithful to this flock! On May 12, 1974 the church relocated to Wicker Street, and gave it a new name: Saint Luke UMC. So, fifty years later, May 12, 2024 we will celebrate our anniversary. Yes, it's Mother's Day. It was also Mother's Day back in 1974.

Bring your mothers, fathers, aunts, uncles, brothers, sisters, cousins ... you get the point. Bring your entire family! You will not want to miss this special day in the life of our church. At 10:00 am there will be a "Social Hour" to enjoy fellowship and greet friends. There will be one worship service at 11:00 am in the sanctuary. Many guests will be with us, including Bishop Paul Leeland, former pastor at Saint Luke UMC and our preacher for this occasion, and Bishop Connie Shelton, the current bishop of the North Carolina Conference. Let's fill our beautiful sanctuary! Come early, and find that special seat for your family and friends. Following worship, we will have a catered meal (free) in the DCLC. 
